INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

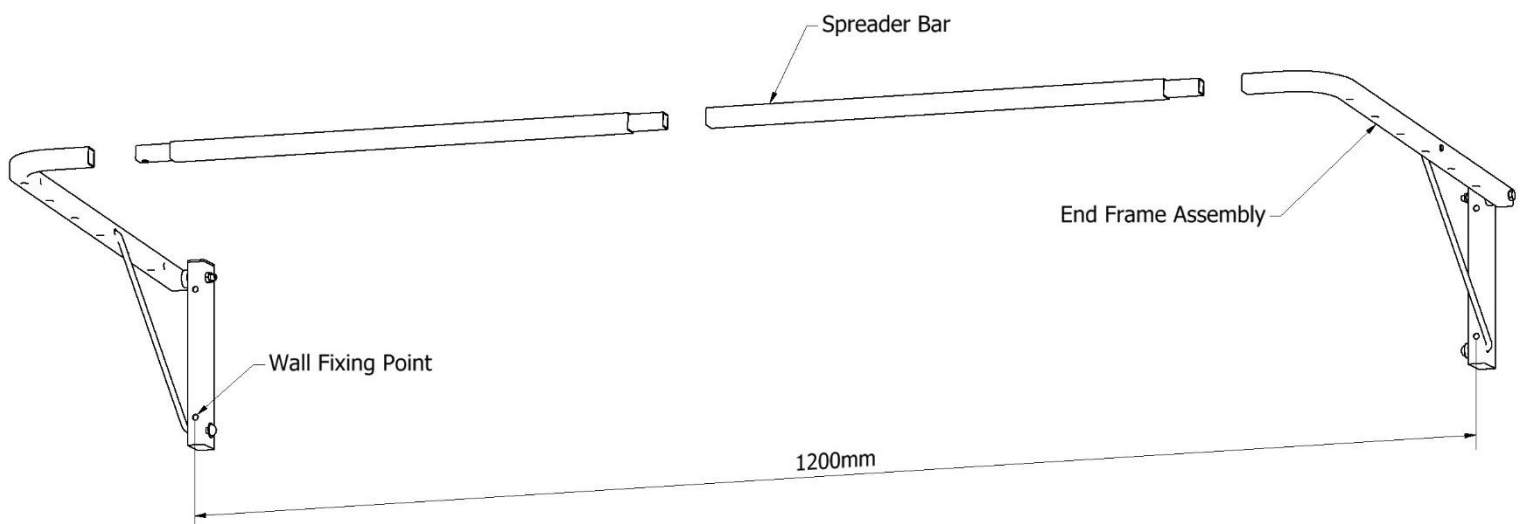
DRILINE CLOTHESLINES

Fasteners must be screwed into structural elements (timber, brick, concrete).
We do not recommend fixing to cladding material or using plasterboard anchors.

Fix 1 End frame to the wall in the desired location using 10 or 12 Gauge screw (not supplied) of sufficient length depending on the wall material. Ensure assembly is plumb (vertical) using a spirit level.

Mark location of second assembly and pre-drill any holes if necessary.

Assemble components as per diagram (leaving the frame folded down will make assembly and mounting easier). Fix second end frame to the wall ensuring that it is plumb.

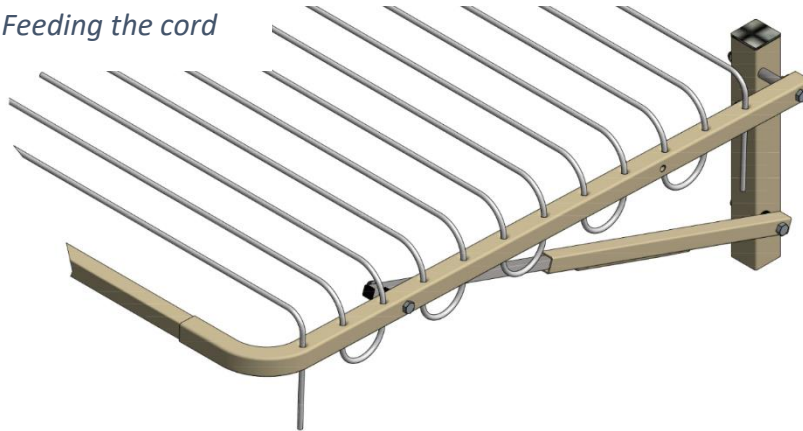


Fold out the arm and hold in place using the wire Stay.

Feeding the cord: (Drawings for illustration purposes only)

- Unroll the cord.
TIP: Always keep hold of the loose ends as this will prevent tangles.
- Feed one end down the hole closest to the wall allowing approx. 300mm for tying.

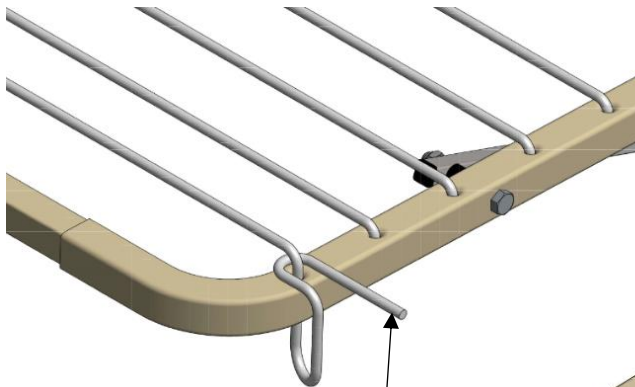
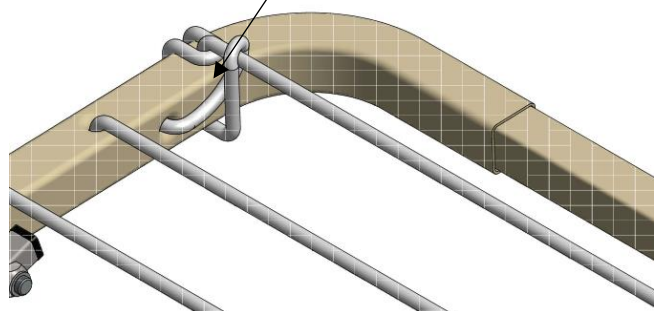


Figure 3 – Tying off

- Tie off as shown in the Figs 3 and 4.
- Feed the cord through the remaining holes as shown in Fig 2.

- To tension the cord, hold the free end tightly. Starting at the line closest to the wall, pull down firmly on the middle of the cord. Repeat the process on the next cord, working your way outwards removing any slack. Repeat the process until there is sufficient tension in the cord.
- Tie the loose end as shown in Figs 3 and 4. Trim the ends of the cord, leaving 100mm to be fed through the hole as shown in Fig 4.

- *Any malfunction of the product must be promptly reported to City Living Clotheslines for immediate attention to prevent further damage. When a user-generated problem is attended to by service Staff a service fee may be applicable.
